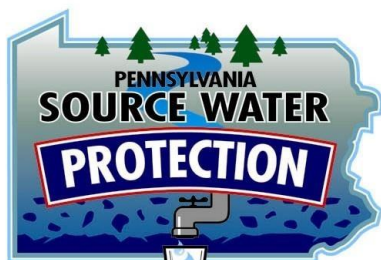

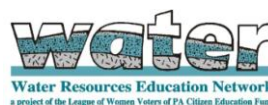
The Source Water Protection 101 Course is designed to equip you with the tools and techniques you need to carry out your land use responsibilities in a manner that will ensure the long-term reliable supply of safe, affordable drinking water.

The Program will also outline the Source Water Protection Program (SWPTAP) available through DEP that offers technical assistance at no out of pocket cost to water systems or municipalities. The Source Water Protection 101 Course is designed for new and experienced officials and planners, and anyone interested in safe drinking water.

Course will cover:

- Basics and components of source water protection
- Types of contaminants and contaminant pathways
- The interrelationship of land use and water
- Source water protection strategies
- Source Water Protection resources available in PA
- Role of public education and involvement
- Multi-municipal opportunities and the emergence of new source water coalitions in Pennsylvania
