Installing a rain garden on your property reduces the amount of pollutants that enter our streams and helps to protect the quality of water for your family now and for future generations. Doylestown Township, Delaware Valley College and the Bucks County Conservation District partnered to receive a 2009 WREN Community Watershed Education Grant to educate residents of the Doylestown community as well as students at Delaware Valley College about the importance of installing rain gardens, rain barrels and other “green” approaches to managing polluted runoff.
